The FHE Student Chapter Officer Elections are scheduled to be held Wednesday, March 7th, at 6:00 p.m. Only students who have paid their 2006-07 \$25 membership fees are eligible to run for office or vote. Current officers are eligible to run for reelection.

The ACHE Officer positions are: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. A copy of the UWM FHE Student Chapter Bylaws that outline the duties and qualifications for each officer is available on the D2L site.

If you would like to run for an office, please follow the following steps;

1. Submit a letter, to Dr.Stegall at sstegall@uwm.edu.

This letter should state: 1) the office you are running for and, 2) why you want to serve, noting also your qualifications to do so, and, 3) include a digital picture. If you do not have a digital picture, please contact Dr. Stegall to arrange a time to take one.

2. These letters will be converted to pdf files and sent to all student associates. They will also be posted on the D2L site.

3. At 6:00 pm on Tuesday, March 7th, students running for office and who submitted letters will begin making brief three minute presentations to the FHE membership. After these students have presented, any student who wishes to run for office as a "write in" candidate will be asked to speak.

4. After the speakers have completed their presentations, Dr. Madsen and Dr.Stegall will conduct the election. A paper ballot will be distributed to each member. The names of the voters will be recorded separately. The ballots will then be collected but the results will not be tabulated until the second week in March.

5. Members that did not attend the Wednesday meeting will be sent an electronic absentee ballot from Dr. Stegall.

This ballot will contain the names of those who presented Wednesday night, with any "write in" candidates so identified.

These ballots must be RETURNED to Dr. Stegall, via his email site.

6. Dr's. Madsen and Stegall will tabulate the votes declare the winners based upon a plurality system. (A run off election will be setup in the case of a tie vote.)

7. The current FHE officers and the candidates will be notified of the results, by the faculty advisers. The FHE president will notify the membership later that day.

Please consider a role as serving as an FHE officer.
